SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR POSTER ABSTRACT

I. Abstract Program Areas:

The poster should focus on either of the following five program areas:

- 1. Goat nutrition and feeding
- 2. Goat reproduction and fertility
- 3. Goat meat and milk production
- 4. Extension and outreach
- 5. Goat processing and marketing

II. Abstract submission guideline:

- 1. To participate on this National Goat Conference poster competition, applicant must first submit an abstract in advance of the conference date.
- 2. The deadline for abstract submission is June 18, 2021 by midnight (cst).
- 3. All abstracts received after this deadline will not be considered and will be returned to the applicants.
- 4. All proposed posters must be the original work of the applicant and coworkers.
- 5. All posters will be reviewed and judged based on criteria established by the committee (see below for detail)
- 6. A winning poster must receive a minimum score of 80/100 points to qualify for an award.
- 7. Awards will be given to the first-place winners in each of the program
- 8. All submissions must be in the English Language.
- 9. Each application needs to include a title as to what the submission will illustrate.
- 10. All abstracts accepted for the competition will be published electronically.
- 11. All abstracts should be sent to Dr. Negusse F Kidane via email @ nfkidane@pvamu.edu

III. Abstract Review Process

- 1. Abstracts received prior to or by the due date will be reviewed by the National Goat Conference Poster Abstract Reviewing Committee.
- 2. Abstracts will be accepted or rejected based on one or more of the following reasons:
 - o Abstracts that are not appropriate to the theme of the conference or do not fulfill the requirements.
 - Abstracts that are duplicate
 - o Abstracts that do not adhere to guideline for submitted category.
