#### **GUIDELINE FOR VIRTUAL POSTER PRESENTATION**

#### PREPARATION OF THE POSTER

- The conference is virtual, and we are only accepting Electronic Poster (E-Poster) in a PDF format
- Poster submission deadline: August 1, 2021
- The poster should be a clear visual presentation of your submitted abstract and should meet the following criteria:
  - o Poster size: Typically the poster must be a dimension of 36" x 48"
  - Every graphic and chart should have a caption or a title, with fully labeled x and y axes.
  - Make sure that you do not exceed the limit of 1 PPT slides for your
    E-Poster
  - o Text and presentation should be in ENGLISH only.
  - Poster should background information, methodology, results, discussion and conclusion in a logical order to reflect the objects of the research.
  - Poster should have clear contrast between the color of the text and the poster's background.
  - Make sure poster text is easy to read, specific sections are easy to locate, and the message is easy to comprehend.
  - Use static images (no embedded videos and animation) for illustration
  - o Use 14 Times New Roman font style for the content of the poster.
  - Title of poster, Name(s) of the Author(s) and Affiliation(s) should be **Bold 18 Times New Roman** font style.
  - Poster should be prepared in Power Point and submitted in PDF format.
  - Every graphic and chart should have a caption or a title, with fully labeled x and y axes.
- All applicants whose poster accepted for presentation will be notified via email.
